### COMPLETE REQUIRED FORMS IN THE AREC SALESPERSON PRE-LICENSURE CANDIDATE PACKET

Vivid will provide you with the packet containing:

- Application for Real Estate License Examination
- Fingerprinting card (State & Federal Criminal Background Check)

You will need a cashier's check or money order for \$86.25 payable to the Arkansas Real Estate Commission (AREC). Also required is a copy of Driver's License and your Vivid Certificate of Completion for the 60-hrs of education. **(5 ITEMS to submit!)**

### RETURN REQUIRED PAPERWORK TO AREC

**IMPORTANT TIME SAVING TIP!** Submit your completed application, fingerprinting card, cashier's check or money order, and copy of DL to the AREC prior to completion of the 60-hr Salesperson Pre-Licensure course.

### NEED REVIEW?

While you are waiting for approval to take your Real Estate exam, you should be studying! Your Vivid instructor will provide you with multiple classroom and online resources to assist you with studying and passing the exam.

### EXAM TIME!

Within 5-10 days after submitting **all** of your paperwork (STEP 2), you should receive your **Certificate of Examination Eligibility**, which means you can now sit for the exam. **The cost to take the exam is \$75.** The electronic, PC-based examination is developed and administered by Pearson Vue. Need more info about the test? Review the **Real Estate Candidate Handbook** that was in your AREC Salesperson Pre-Licensure Candidate Packet.

### DID YOU PASS THE EXAM?

Pearson Vue will provide you your score report at completion of the exam. If you pass the exam, you will take the score report to the brokerage of your choice and the broker will sign the score report, and it will need to be returned, along with a \$75 license activation fee, to the Arkansas Real Estate Commission. Once the signed score report is received **AND** the state and federal background checks are satisfactory, your license will be issued. You will **not** be able to conduct real estate business until your license has been received by the broker.
